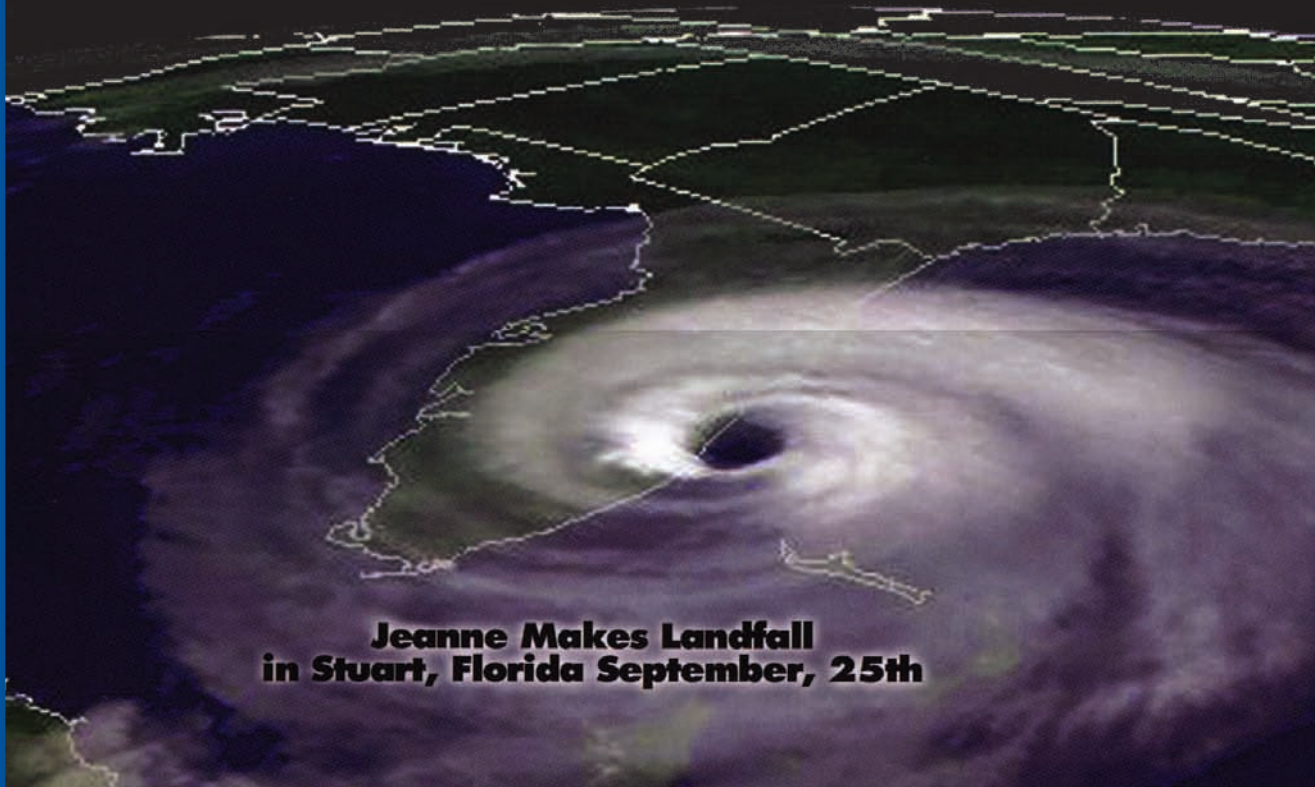

Hurricane	Florida Landfall	Max Sustained Winds	Damage
Charley	Punta Gorda, August 13	145 MPH	\$6.8 Billion
Frances	Stuart, September 5	120 MPH	\$4.4 Billion
Ivan	Near Pensacola, Sept 13	150 MPH	\$4-7 Billion
Jeanne	Stuart, September 25	120 MPH	\$4-7 Billion
